Enrolling in a Women's/Gender Studies certificate program gives you access to courses that keep women's and gender issues in mind while engaging in the course material.

Courses offered may address: women's experiences throughout history and in many cultures, constructions and representations of gender in the media, sexual identities, community and cultural perspectives of gender, trans, queer and women's history and the politics of feminism.

We also organize regular student run activities and events. Our comedy stand-up acts, meet & greets, special film screenings, and Women's Week have attracted the whole Dawson community.

How it works:

Students in any program of study can take courses in Women's/Gender Studies. Upon completion of 5 Women's/Gender Studies courses offered in general education, complimenatry and/or a chosen program of study, students will be awarded certificates attesting to their studies in the field. Once enrolled we will track your progress online. A certificate ceremony happens every May for those who have completed Women's/Gender Studies.
